

#### REA (Now called OCIA) What is OCIA?

It is a journey of faith for those who are searching and inquiring about what the Catholic Church teaches and believes. While this program is oriented for adults, mature teenagers may also participate.

Who should attend OCIA?

- Those who have never been baptized in the Christian faith.
- Those baptized in another Christian faith tradition who would like to become Catholic.
- Those who were baptized Catholic but did not continue to practice the faith or who have never participated in the Sacraments of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

The initial phase of OCIA is called inquiry or the pre-catechumenate. Inquiry sessions meet year-round; people interested in starting OCIA don't have to wait until September to begin the journey.


