Red Cross Blood Drive

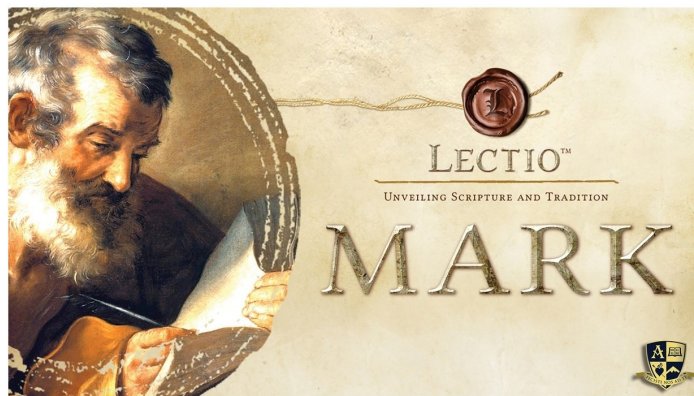
