SPONSOR/GODPARENT ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

Role of a Godparent/Sponsor

To be a godparent/sponsor is both an honor and an awesome responsibility, as it calls one to draw even deeper into the heart of Christ to gain wisdom in guiding the spiritual life of the candidate in the ways of Christ and His Church. The godparent/sponsor, together with the parents, must be willing to help the baptized/confirmed grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparent/sponsor will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligation connected with it. (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872)

"To be admitted to the role of sponsor (godparent), a person must be able to profess with the parents the church's faith when the child is being baptized and be able to help the parents as necessary to bring up the child as a good Christian. They must have completed the sixteenth year of age, unless the diocesan bishop has established another age, or an exception is made for a special reason. Be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist and leads a life of faith in keeping with the role of the sponsor; not be bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared; not be the father or the mother of the one to be baptized." (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 874)
